Eighth Grade Parent/guardians:

Promotion Activity packets went home with all 8th grade students this week. Please ask you child for it if they have not given it to you.

- We have changed the reporting time for the morning of Tuesday, June 11. All participating Disney students must report to their homeroom class **at 8:00am**. Buses will leave the Dana campus by 8:30am.
- All activity forms and payments are due back to Mrs. Ory by Wednesday, May 22. The letter indicated no checks, but we are making an exception up until Friday, May 17. This is a firm check cut-off date.
- If your child received a “conditional” notification you must still send in the form and payment by the May 22 due date. We hope that all of our students will qualify, but will also refund payments if needed.
- If you do not plan for your child to participate in either the Disneyland activity or promotion ceremony you must fill out and sign the bottom portion of the ½ sheet payment form and return it to Mrs. Ory as soon as possible.
- Although Promotion gowns have been ordered for all students, if you have a promotion gown from a sibling who promoted from Dana in recent years, your current eighth grader may use it if it fits and is in good condition. Contact Mrs. Ory for more information.
